

## Summer Virtual Teaching Workshop Series

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### June 18—Mentoring virtual students (1/2 day)

The virtual mentor plays a critical role in helping students feel comfortable in the online environment and also works closely with the online instructor to address the specific learning needs of their students. This workshop includes an introduction to the virtual course environment, an overview to the diverse learning needs of the online student, and training in the skills and techniques needed to effectively support students participating in online courses.

### June 19—Getting started as a virtual educator (1 day)

Teaching in an online environment can often prove to be a daunting task. From the facilitation of higher order thinking skills within discussion boards to the task of authentic assessment, there are many details to consider. This workshop will help teachers explore the skills needed to be successful teachers in an online environment. Tools, resources, and best practices will be shared during this full day session.

### July 9—Tools and resources for the virtual educator (1/2 day)

Where can a virtual teacher find resources that will enrich the courses they are teaching? What ideas exist to help modify content to meet the needs of the students? This workshop will focus on existing resources to improve online courses and provide best practices for improvement of online instruction.
